

# Scoring of community activities

## Chapter 1 Purpose

These guidelines determine the scoring of community activities in accordance with section 9 of the AYY scholarship regulation for the community scholarship, study scholarship and exchange scholarship referred to in section 1 of the regulation. In accordance with section 9 of the scholarship regulation, the scoring takes into account duties and positions that have ended before the beginning of the current year and the meetings of university administration and the Representative Council, which have been held before the beginning of the current year.

## Chapter 2 Calculation of community activity scores

### 1 § Method of calculation

Community activity scores are determined by adding together the points presented in this chapter for duties and positions provided by the applicant. Points may be granted several times for the same position if the applicant has held the position for several years or has served in several positions under the same title. The maximum of three (3) positions per year can be entered in the application. If the position includes participation in section/committee/other activities, this is included under the same position and taken into account in scoring. The total number of points is divided by 2 before comparing the points with the total score of the applicants.

Applicants estimate their contribution on a case-by-case basis, giving themselves points at the provided scale by estimating their own weekly workload. The minimum score includes about 1 hour of work per week and the maximum score includes 20 hours of work per week. The applicant provides grounds for the estimated score for different positions.

Community activity points are not granted for the activities of invite-only clubs or tasks in which you work as an employee.

At the discretion of the allocation committee, points may also be granted for AYY activities or activities close to AYY, which are not specifically mentioned in these guidelines. In such case, points must be granted in line with the points allocated for duties and positions described in these guidelines.

In accordance with section 7 of the scholarship regulation, the allocation committee has the right to make a different interpretation of the score proposed by the applicant, in which case the interpretation of the allocation committee prevails.
